Sinn Féin is campaigning for:

- The Irish government to bring forward a strategy to achieve national self-determination, Irish re-unification and national reconciliation.
- The Taoiseach to commission a Green Paper on Irish unity to identify steps to promote and assist a successful transition to a united Ireland.
- A Minister of State should be appointed to co-ordinate the Government's all-Ireland policies.
- The British Government to become persuaders for Irish unity and develop policies to end their jurisdiction in Ireland.
- Widespread consultation at home and abroad. Every effort must be made to engage with unionist opinion and to engage with them about the nature and form a new Ireland will take.
- An all-Ireland economy has huge potential for economic growth across the island. The separation of two economies, duplication of services, competing strategies and two currencies have all had a negative impact.
- In the short term proposals for Northern representation in the Oireachtas and voting rights in Presidential elections for those resident in the Six Counties should be advanced.
